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a pioneering work of science business insider this book helped launch modern environmental computer modeling and began our current globally focused environmental debate a scientifically rigorous and credible warning the nation in 1972 three scientists from mit created a computer model that analyzed global resource consumption and production their results shocked the world and created stirring conversation about global overshoot or resource use beyond the carrying capacity of the planet now preeminent environmental scientists donnella meadows jorgen randers and dennis meadows have teamed up again to update and expand their original findings in the limits to growth the 30 year global update meadows randers and meadows are international environmental leaders recognized for their groundbreaking research into early signs of wear on the planet citing climate change as the most tangible example of our current overshoot the scientists now provide us with an updated scenario and a plan to reduce our needs to meet the carrying capacity of the planet over the past three decades population growth and global warming have forged on with a striking semblance to the scenarios laid out by the world3 computer model in the original limits to growth while meadows randers and meadows do not make a practice of predicting future environmental degradation they offer an analysis of present and future trends in resource use and assess a variety of possible outcomes in many ways the message contained in limits to growth the 30 year update is a warning overshoot cannot be sustained without collapse but as the authors are careful to point out there is reason to believe that humanity can still reverse some of its damage to earth if it takes appropriate measures to reduce inefficiency and waste written in refreshingly accessible prose limits to growth the 30 year update is a long anticipated revival of some of the original voices in the growing chorus of sustainability limits to growth the 30 year update is a work of stunning intelligence that will expose for humanity the hazy but critical line between human growth and human development

climate change a familiar term today is far more than just global warming due to atmospheric greenhouse gases including co2 in order to understand the nature of climate change it is necessary to consider the whole climatic system its complexity and the ways in which natural and anthropogenic activities act and influence that system

and the environment over the past 20 years since the first edition of understanding global climate change was published not only has the availability of climate related data and computer modelling changed but our perceptions of it and its impact have changed as well using a combination of ground data satellite data and human impacts this second edition discusses the state of climate research today on a global scale and establishes a background for future discussions on climate change this book is an essential reference text relevant to any and all who study climate and climate change features provides a thought provoking and original approach to the science of climate emphasises that there are many factors contributing to the causation of climate change clarifies that while anthropogenic generation of carbon dioxide is important it is only one of several human activities contributing to climate change considers climate change responses needed to be undertaken by politicians and society at national and global levels totally revised and updated with state of the art satellite data and climate models currently in operation around the globe

increased throughput of carbon based fossil energy the destruction of earth's forests and other land use changes have resulted in ever higher levels of waste in the form of greenhouse gases as well as a diminished capacity of the planet to absorb and store those wastes this means that to avoid catastrophic global warming and maintain the habitat

combining a large amount of new data more powerful computer modelling and the latest thinking on sustainability ecological footprinting and limits this updated edition of limits to growth makes an even more urgent case for a rapid readjustment of the global economy toward a sustainable path

growing metropolitan region of south east queensland centred on brisbane and the national capital of canberra these essays are contributed by some of australia s leading urbanists set against a dynamic background of economic change restructured land uses a more diverse population and growing spatial and social inequality the book identifies a broad planning consensus around the notion of making australian cities more contained compact and resilient but it also observes a continuing gulf between the simplified aims of metropolitan strategies and our growing understanding of the complex functioning of the varied communities in which most people live this book reflects on the raft of planning challenges presented at the metropolitan scale looks at what the future of australian cities might be and speculates about the prospects of more effective metropolitan planning arrangements
